Diabetes Indicators by Practice and CHP 2009-10

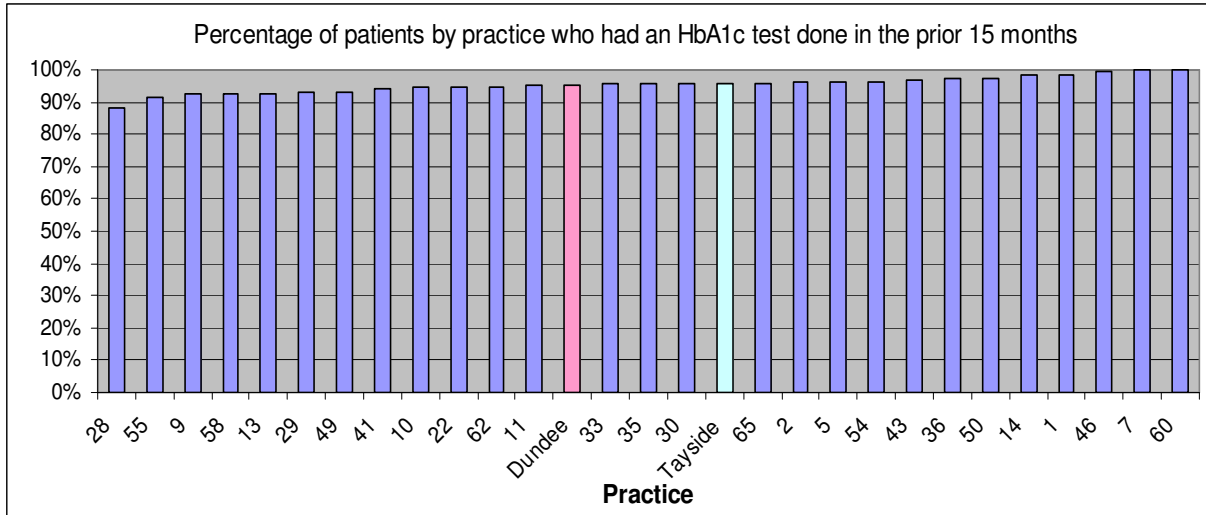

This report has been produced from data communicated to SCI-DC (Scottish Care Information-Diabetes Collaborative) during the period 01/01/2009 to 31/03/2010.

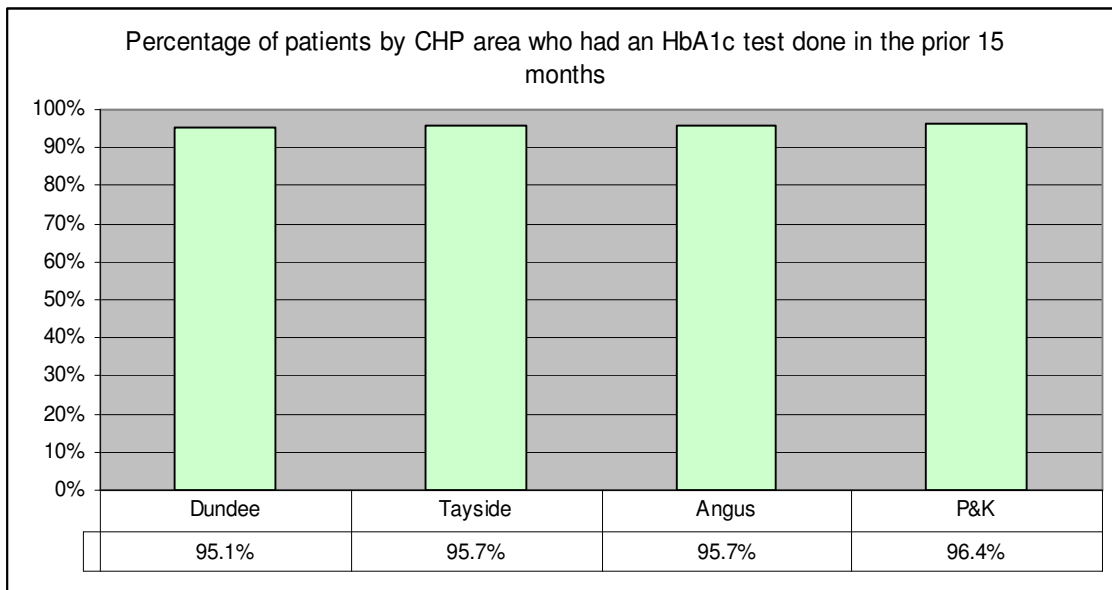

Each practice has been assigned a random, anonymised code number and this is displayed on the x-axis of each graph to identify their current standing.

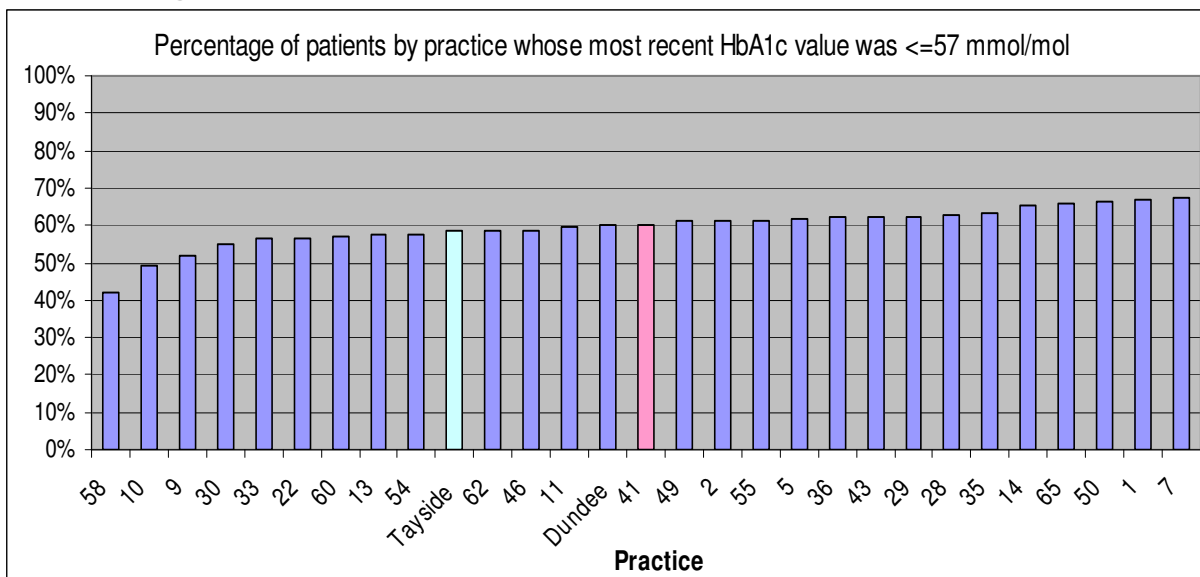

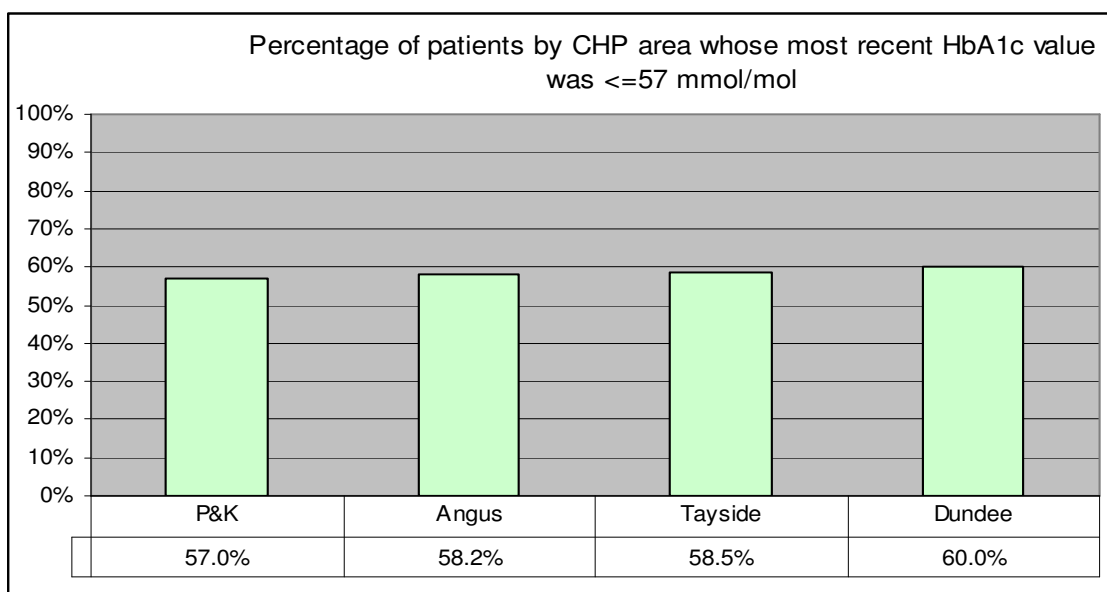

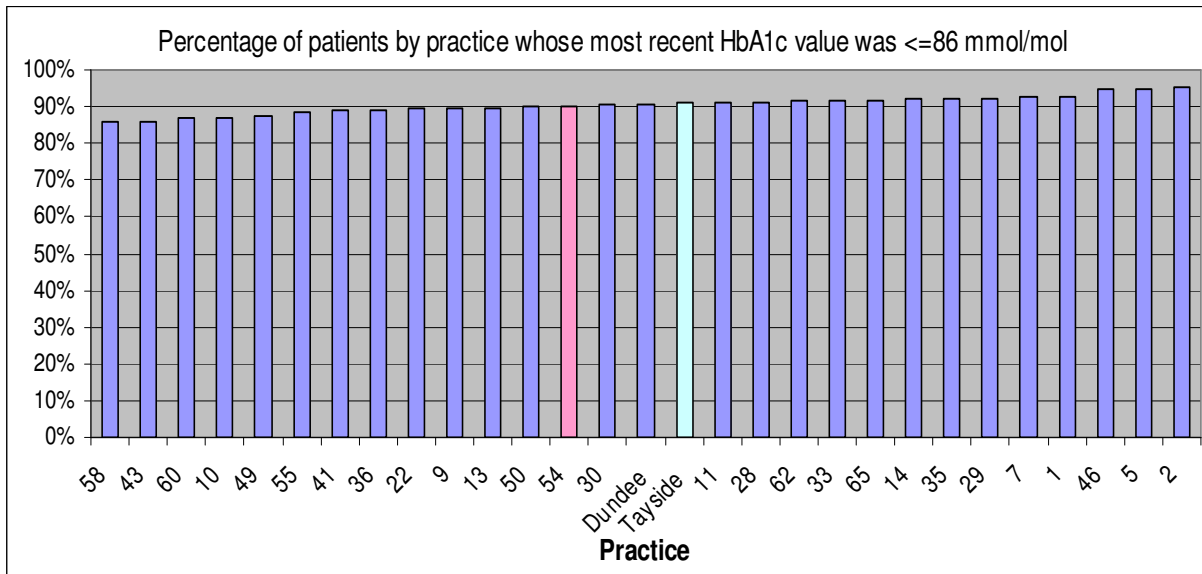
Hba1c targets



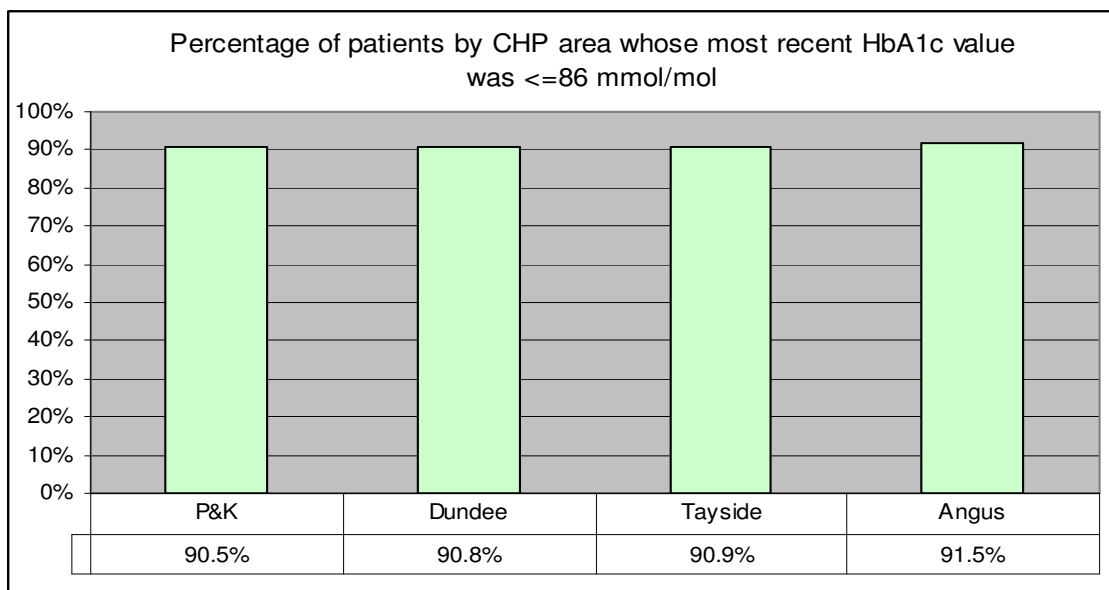

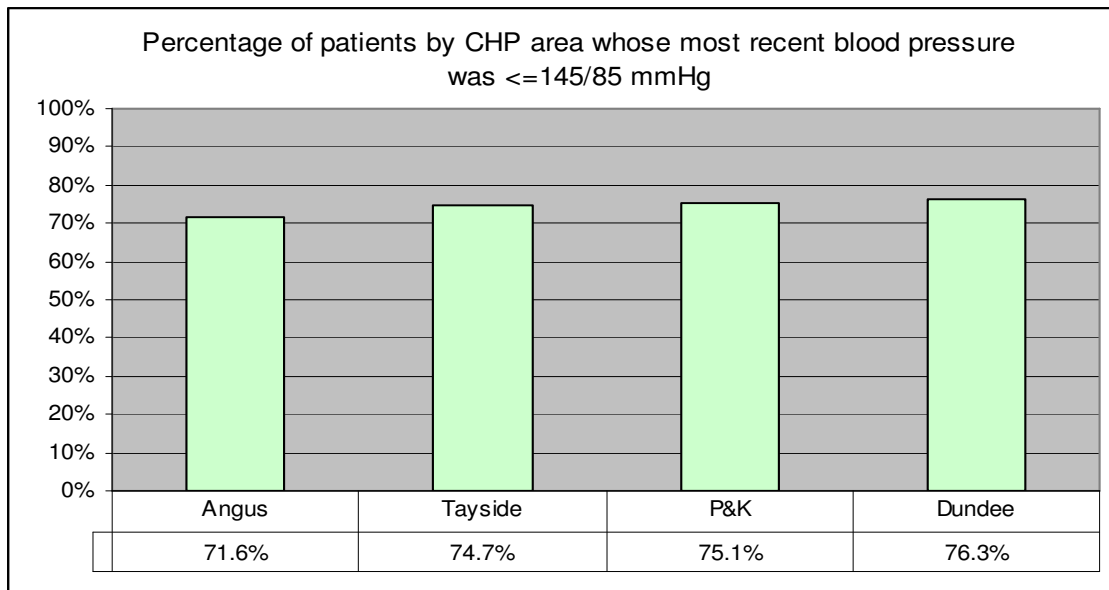

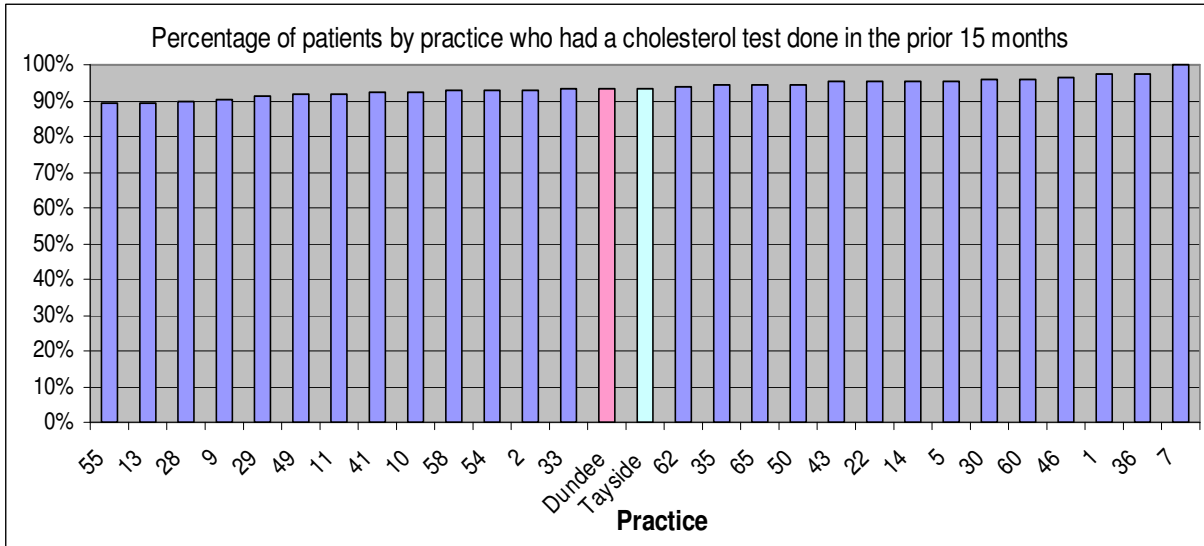

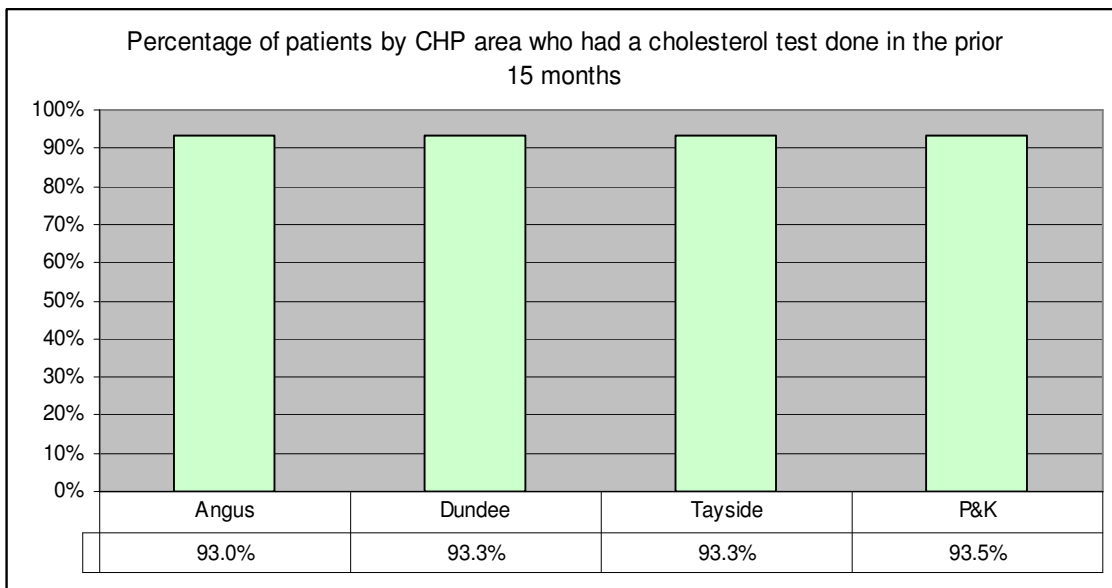
Blood pressure targets



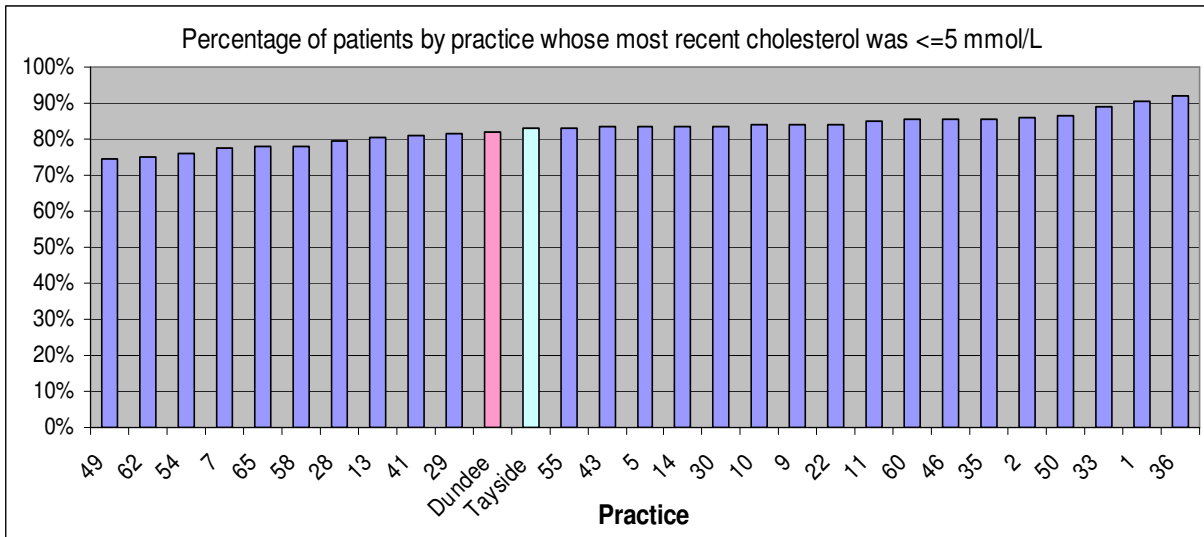

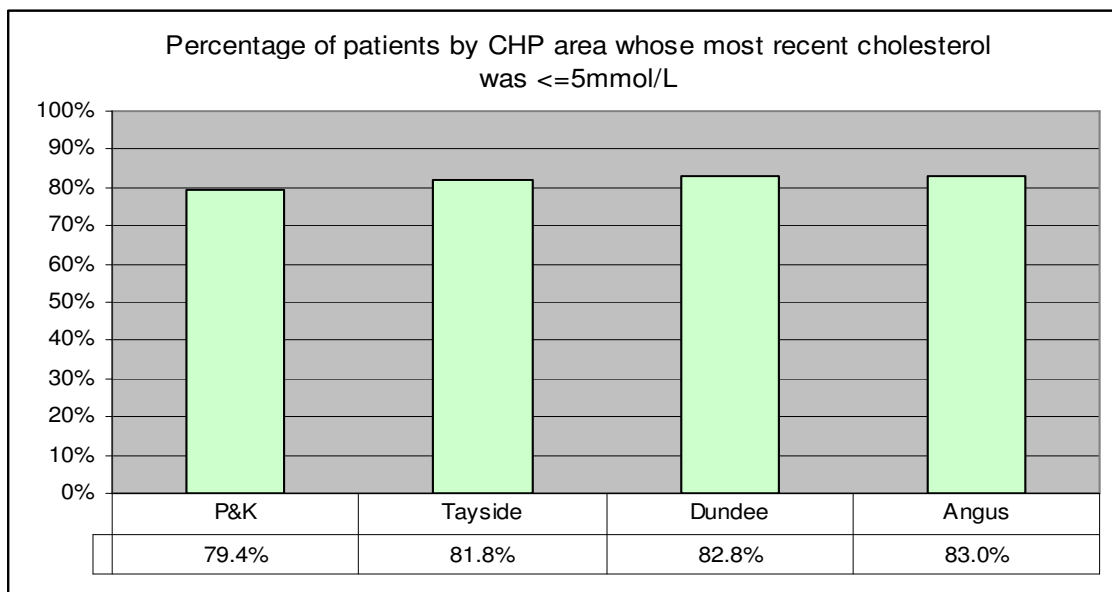

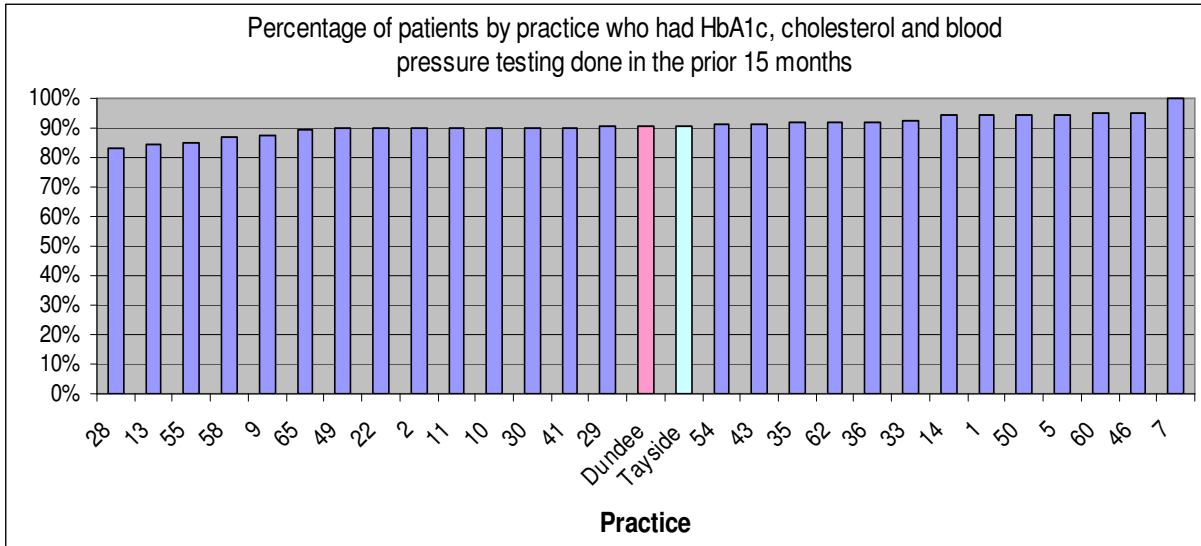
Cholesterol targets



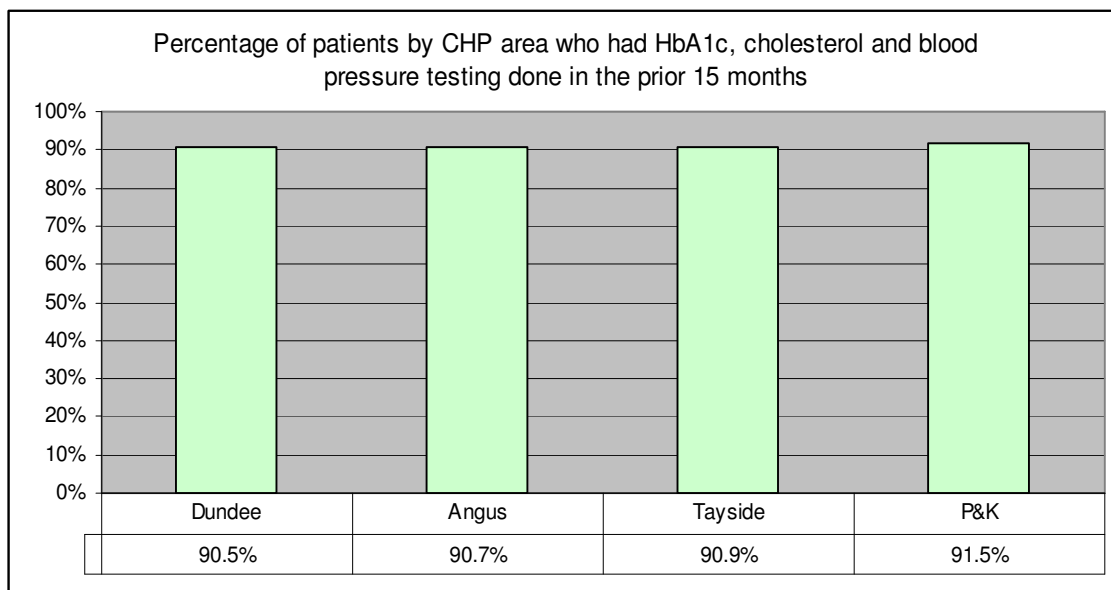

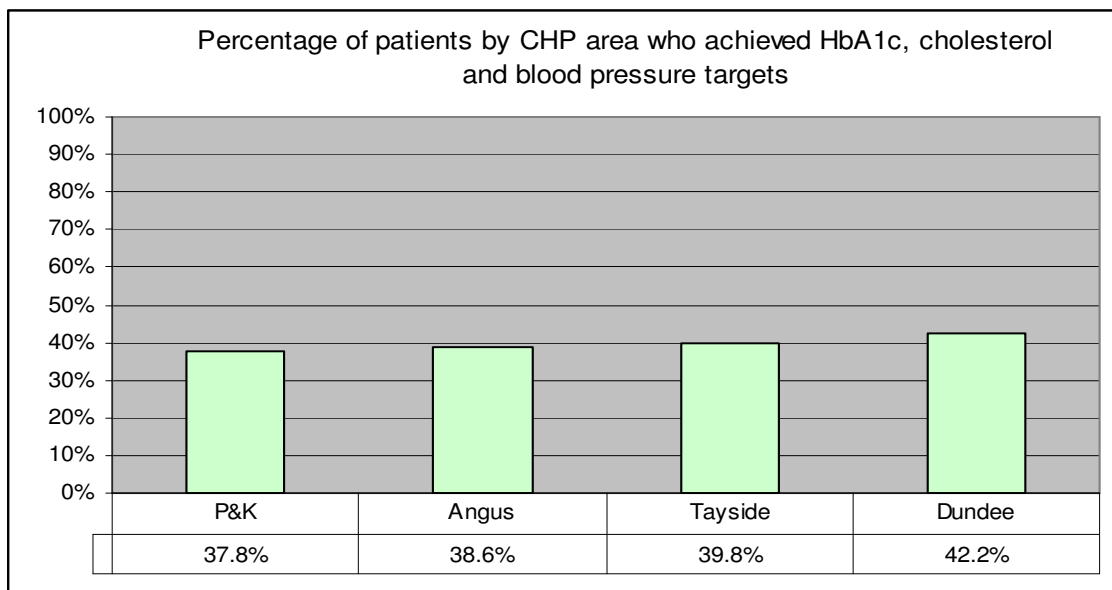
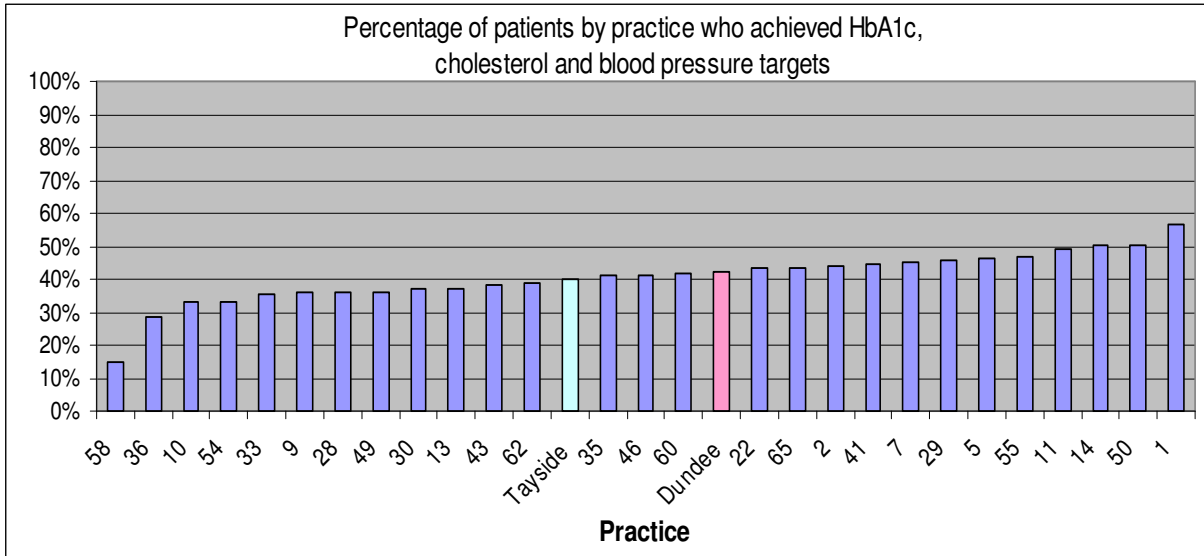
Combined HbA1c, Blood pressure and cholesterol testing



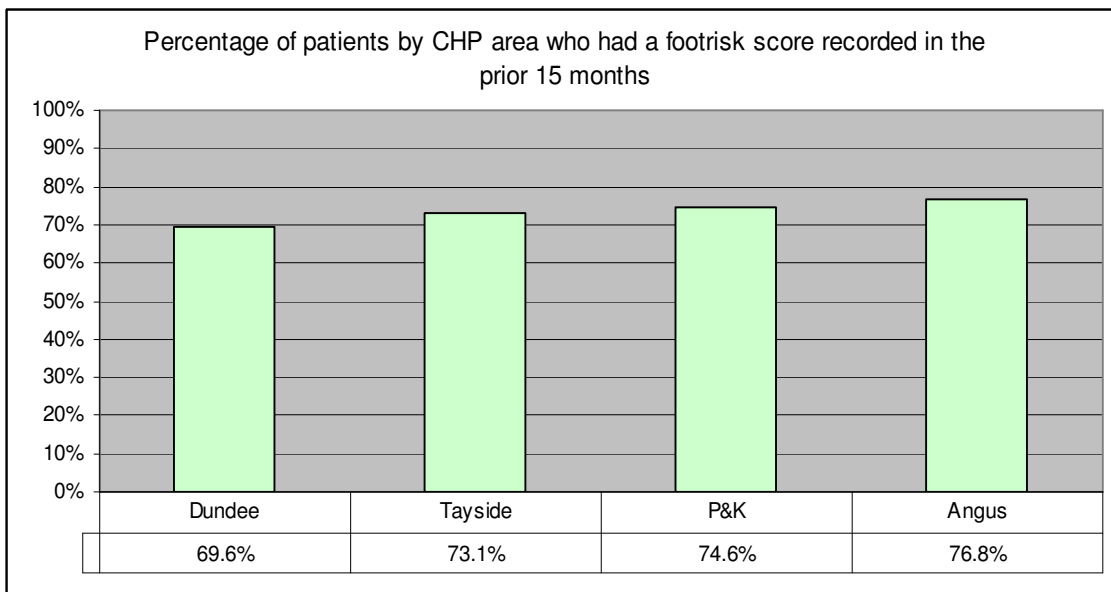
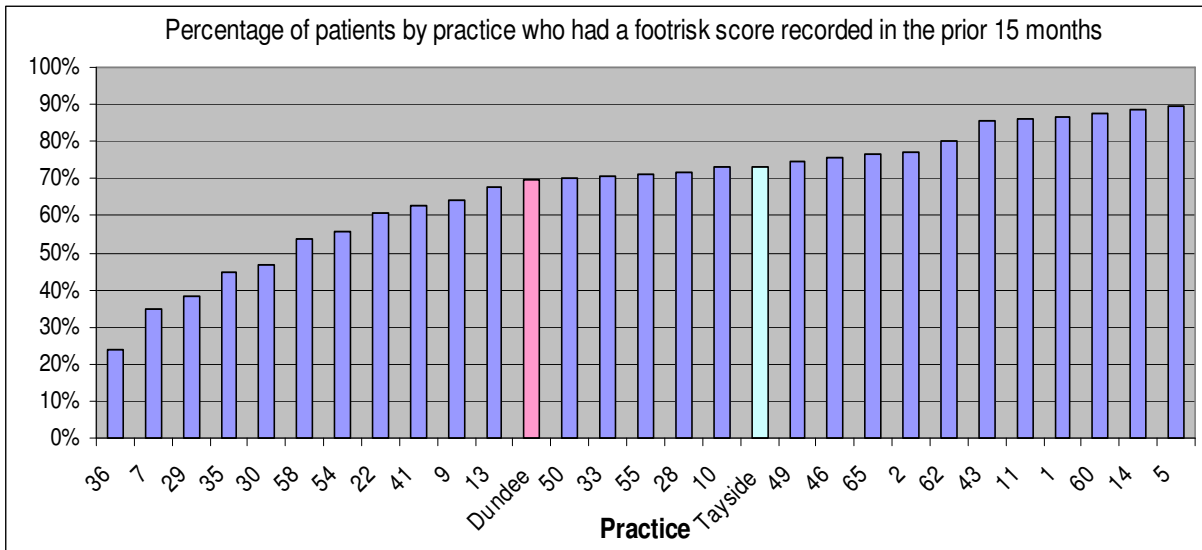

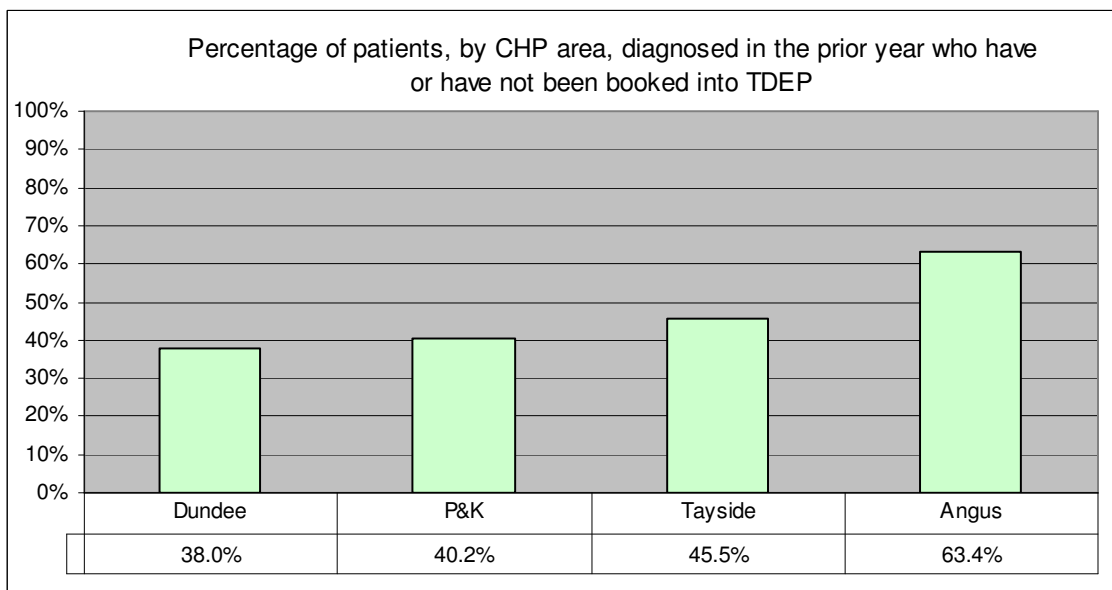
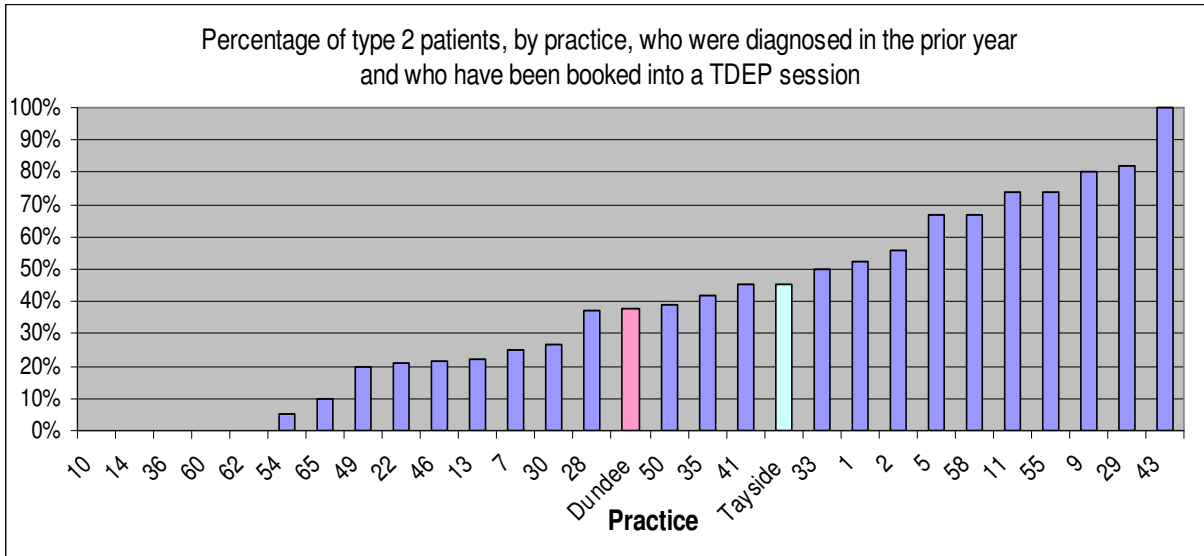
Combined HbA1c, Blood pressure and cholesterol targets



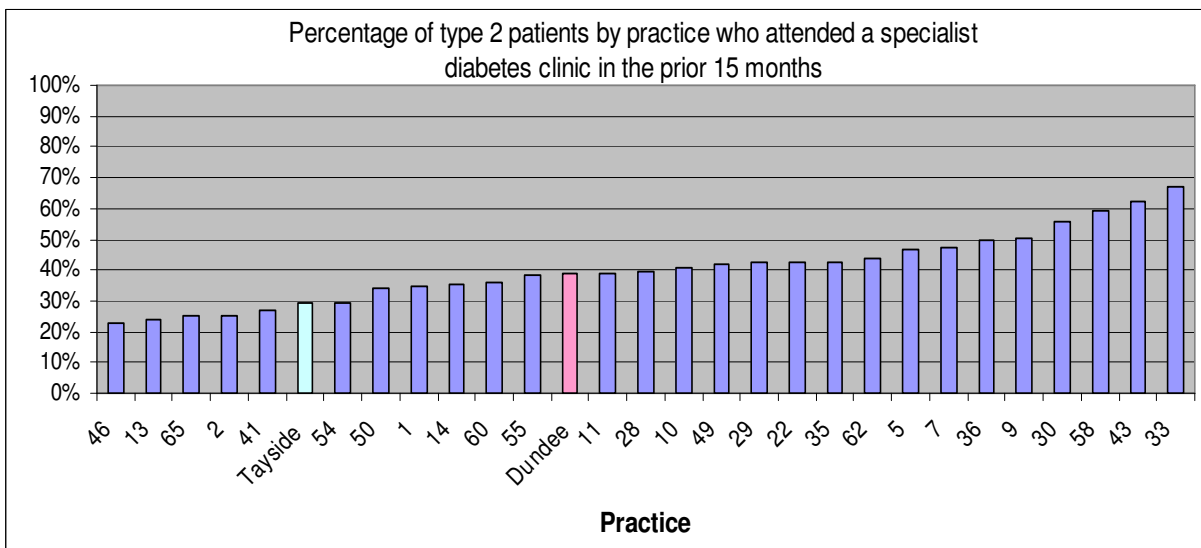
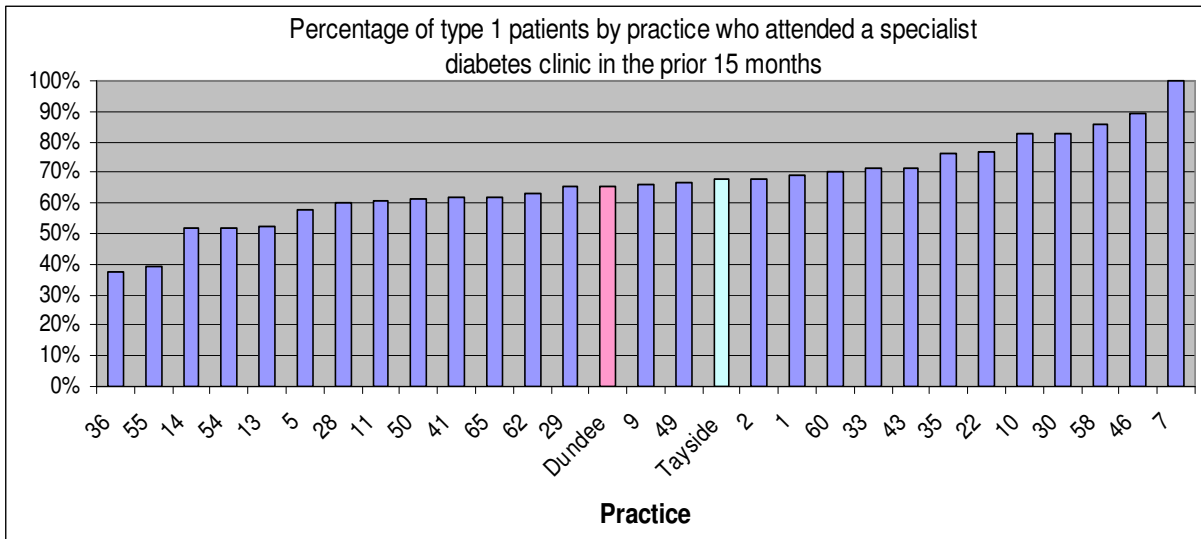
